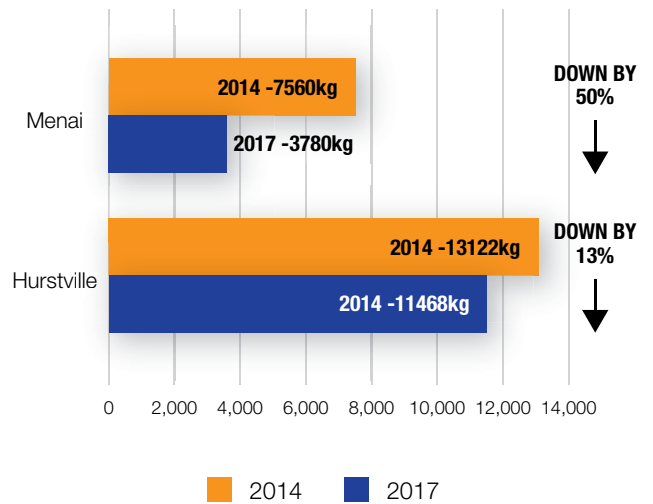
Club Central has been working hard over the past few years looking for ways to reduce our impact on the environment, save money and demonstrate how our business is operating in a sustainable way.

## Tracking our environmental impact

We've been monitoring our resource use and emissions across both Clubs since 2013. This helps identify areas where we could be making improvements and measure the effectiveness of new initiatives.

We've achieved impressive results in the reduction of waste to landfill across both Menai and Hurstville thanks to better recycling programs as well as the introduction of ORCA food processing units at both sites. This digests up to 110 kilos of food waste per day and turns it into environmentally safe water that flows straight into the sewage system.

On Tuesday 6 March, Club Central organised a Community Clean Up of Menai Conservation Park, adjacent to Club Central, for Clean Up Australia Day 2018.

Some of our fantastic Club Central staff volunteered their own time to come and lend a hand as did a crew from nearby youth service, Project Youth.

It's our aim to make this an annual clean up and recruit Club Central members who are interested in preserving and improving our local environment to join us in future.
